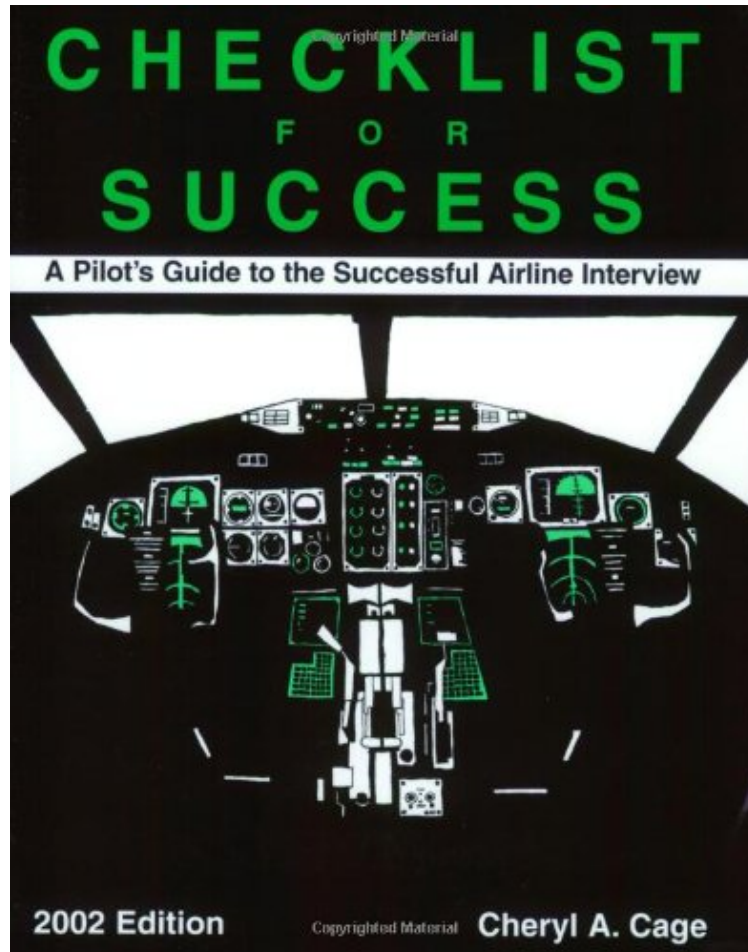

I used the recommendations in this book and tailored them to my individual needs. What transpired was a well prepped interviewee. No you will not have an answer to every question asked.
