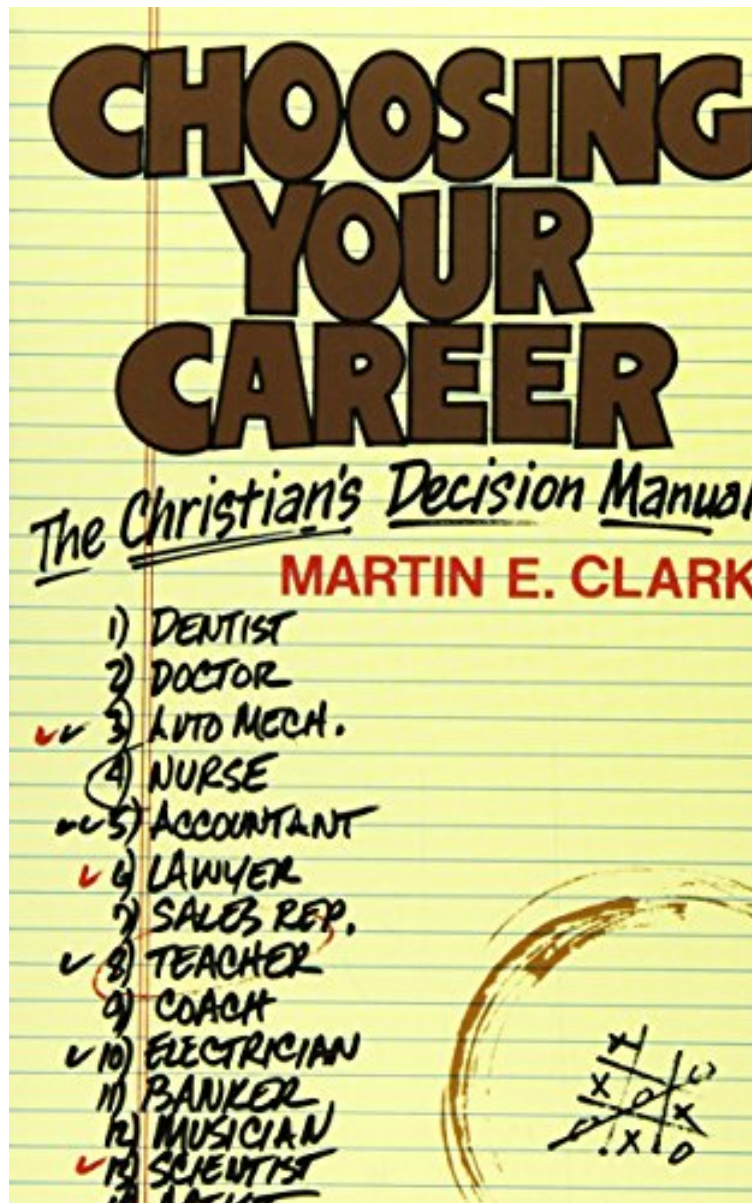

the BEST career book I've ever read - I only wish we'd had it with our first two kiddos. The author takes your child (and you) through various analyses of their natural talents and interests - helping them to identify more than just "apparent gifts." Interests examined include what sort of lifestyle they'd like to lead in the future (adventurous, traveling, staying in one place, etc.), whether or not team effort is more important to them than individual recognition, risk thresholds, and personal value questions. All these items are discussed in the light of God's Word - and examined rationally - not just emotionally. Societal gender prejudices are explored (ie: discouraging men from the arts due to low pay) and whether or not assorted interests are at "hobby level," or something they'd really like to pursue full time as a career. Scripture is applied consistently to each consideration and within context of the subject studied. Students are asked to get the opinions of trusted adults as to their specific strengths as well - helping to identify areas that might not have been previously considered by the student or parents. I was surprised by some of the answers given by each of my teens, and it helped me to direct them to find more resources in new career considerations. This is a worthwhile group or individual study and each participant will need their own copy to do the chapter questions.

Combines innovative concepts and exercises with relevant scriptural principles for knowing God's will. High school students, college students, and adults will all profit from this book.
