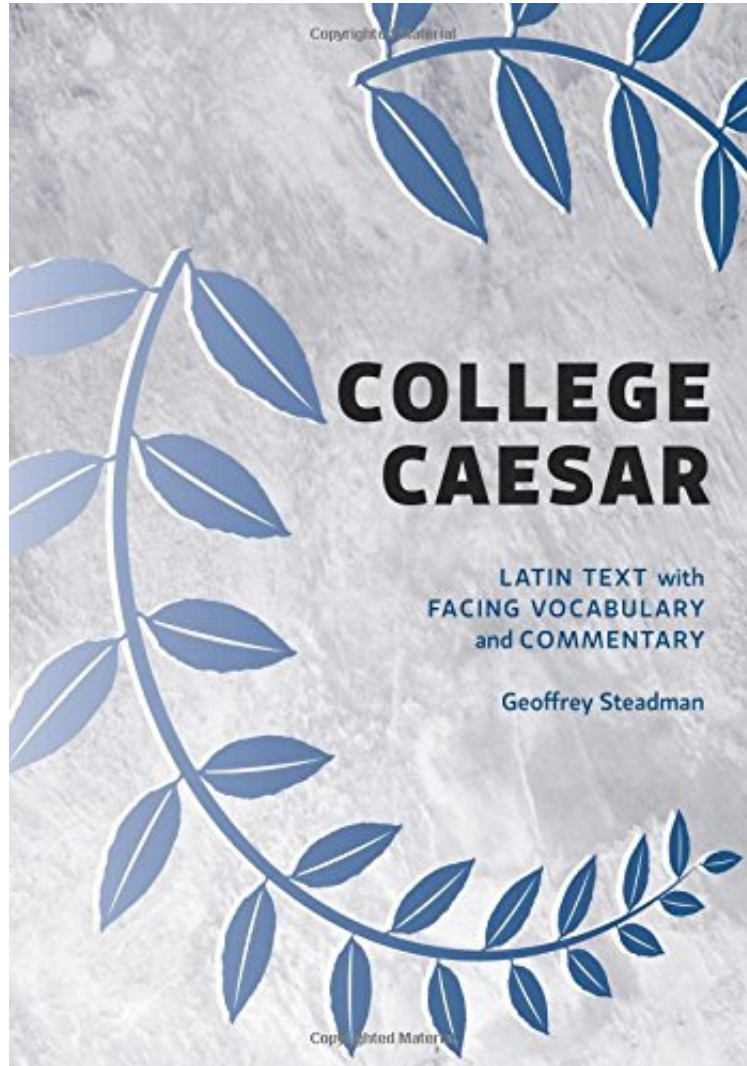

The vocabulary for the text on each page can be found at the bottom, and explanatory notes are on the opposite page. A list of essential, high-frequency

words is included at the beginning of the book. It is presumed that the student will already know this much Latin (a comparatively modest amount). The result is a text that is as accessible as it is rewarding. More advanced Latin students will perhaps find the the text's vocabulary and annotation something of an overkill, but this excellent book opens up the world through Caesar's eyes very effectively.
