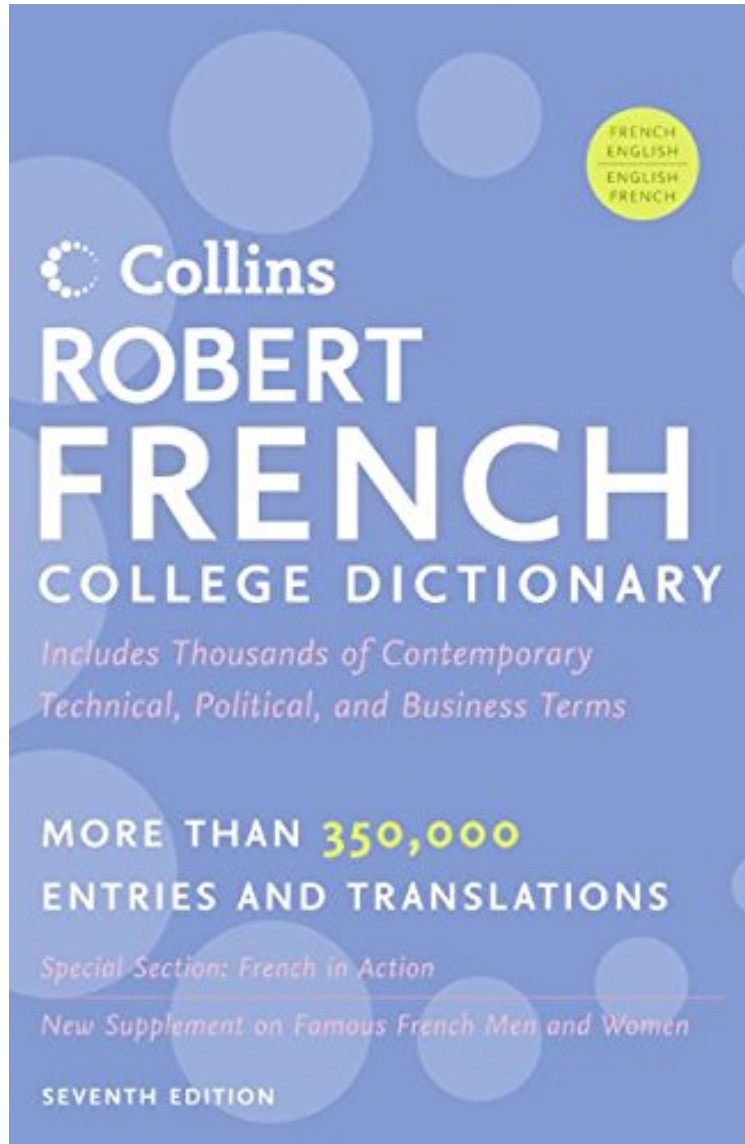

The book is large and heavy, so it's perhaps not great for lugging around all the time, but it's still smaller than most of my textbooks. There's a nice section in the middle that goes through things like useful sentences, expressing opinions, expressing indifference, apologies, greetings, how to address an envelope properly, how to start and end personal or formal correspondence, how to format a CV, an email, or a business letter, types of phone calls, and also a French verb table. This dictionary was well priced and well balanced between a pocket dictionary and full dictionary.
