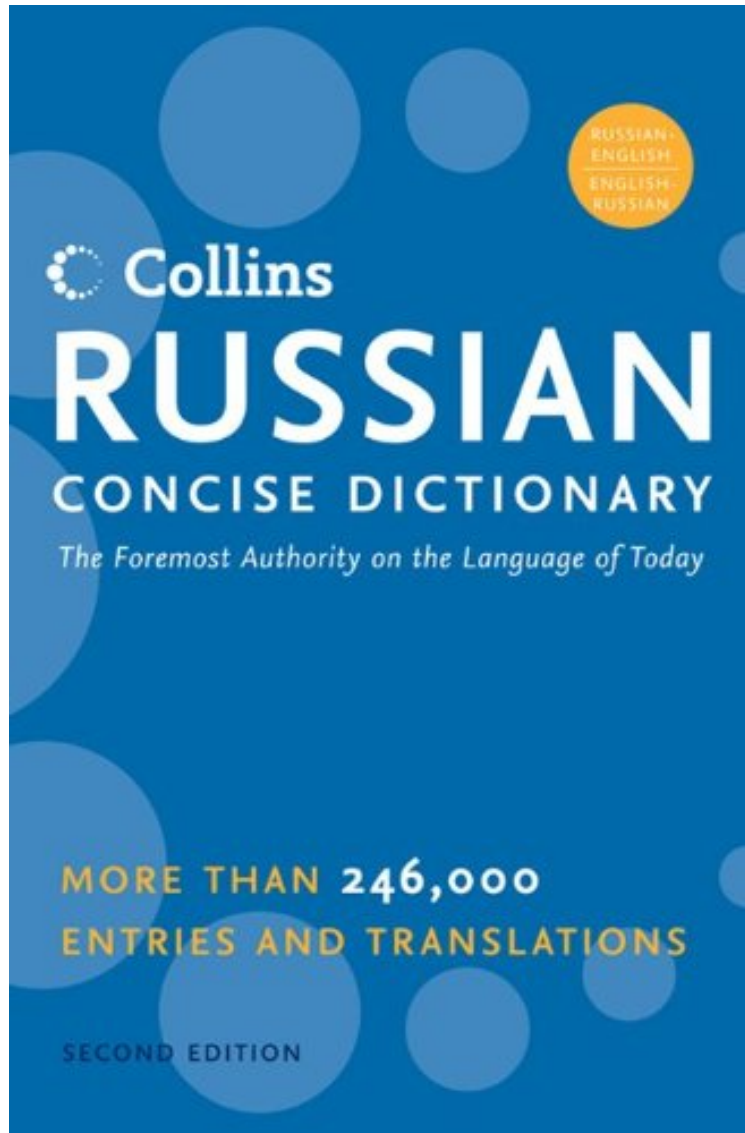

So I was looking to see grammar reference in addition to the dictionary, but I didn't find any 250-page grammar section. Instead, there is a 9-page 'Guide to Russian Grammar' section after the Russian-English dictionary. Maybe this is an issue with US edition but I'm disappointed the dictionary didn't fit the description.
