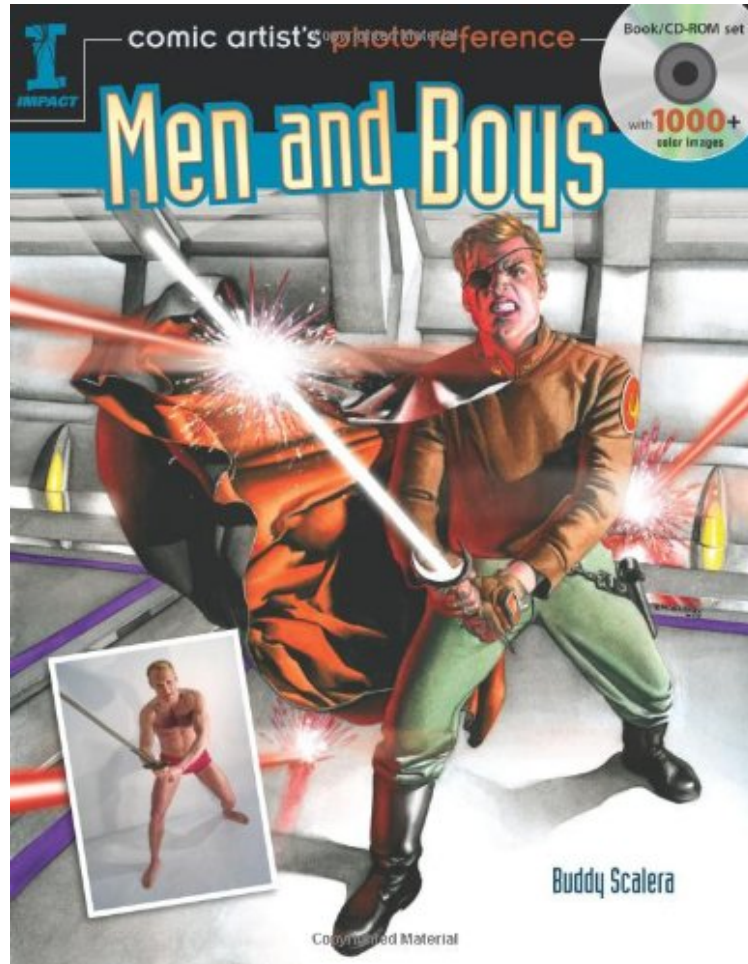

Thank you, Buddy Scalera! 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. a decent reference for a specific style of story telling, disappointing cd extra By thomas j bolger I picked this book up as well as a few others by this author to begin work on a comic and while it's decent enough reference for what it is, I have several issues with both the presentation of the book and the execution of the photography within it. Firstly, the CD, while I suppose it was on some level presumptuous of me to assume that the cd would contain all of the photography within the book. The cd extras are a little thin particularly for a book that has been released in the last 5 years. Also, the layout of the book itself is, not confusing, but in an attempt to be 'dynamic' it's over designed and fails at its purpose namely packing as much photo reference on the page as possible. Finally, while production values don't need to be much of a factor given this book's intended purpose, some better lighting and attention to focus would be much appreciated. All in all, worth the dough particularly for artists who know how to draw but are new to sequential storytelling of the cape and cowl variety, Scelera does a great job of capturing the tropes of the genre. My biggest problem is I picked up 3 books by the author this one another called 'Women and Girls' and a third called Colossal Collection of Action Poses, which is simply this and the 'Women and Girls' repackaged with no CD, so that's kind of a drag. Ultimately your best bet would be to eschew the cd's and go for the All in one Colossal collection.
