Almost 5000 entries, which include abbreviations, were selected to meet the day-to-day needs of the general reader of popular magazines and newspapers. It is not intended to compete with the major standard work, Acronyms, Initialisms Abbreviations Dictionary (Gale, 1987. 12th ed.), but librarians might wish to compare some other one-volume sources, such as Pugh's Dictionary of Acronyms and Abbreviations (Library Assn./ALA, 1987), which has over 18,000 entries.
