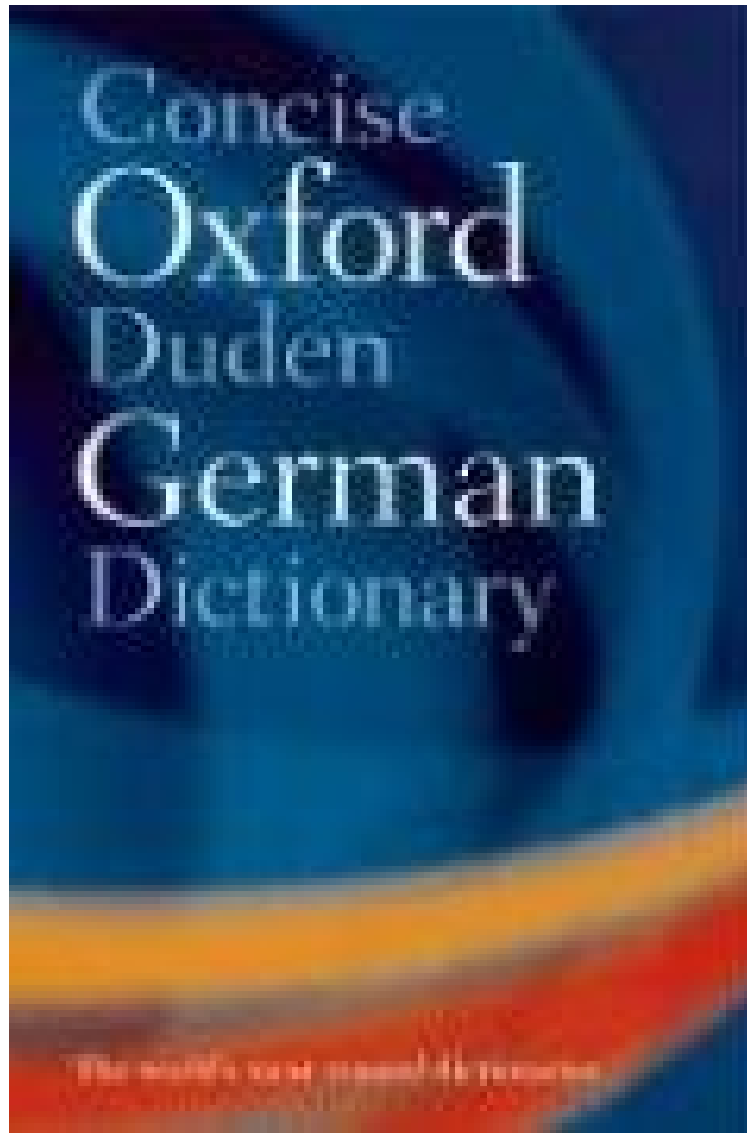

provides an extensive tool for translating from German to English. My edition does seem to have a printing error in which part of the "V" and "W" sections in German are printed upside down. Considering the small price I paid, I don't mind flipping my dictionary around occasionally. Overall, I would recommend using this dictionary.
