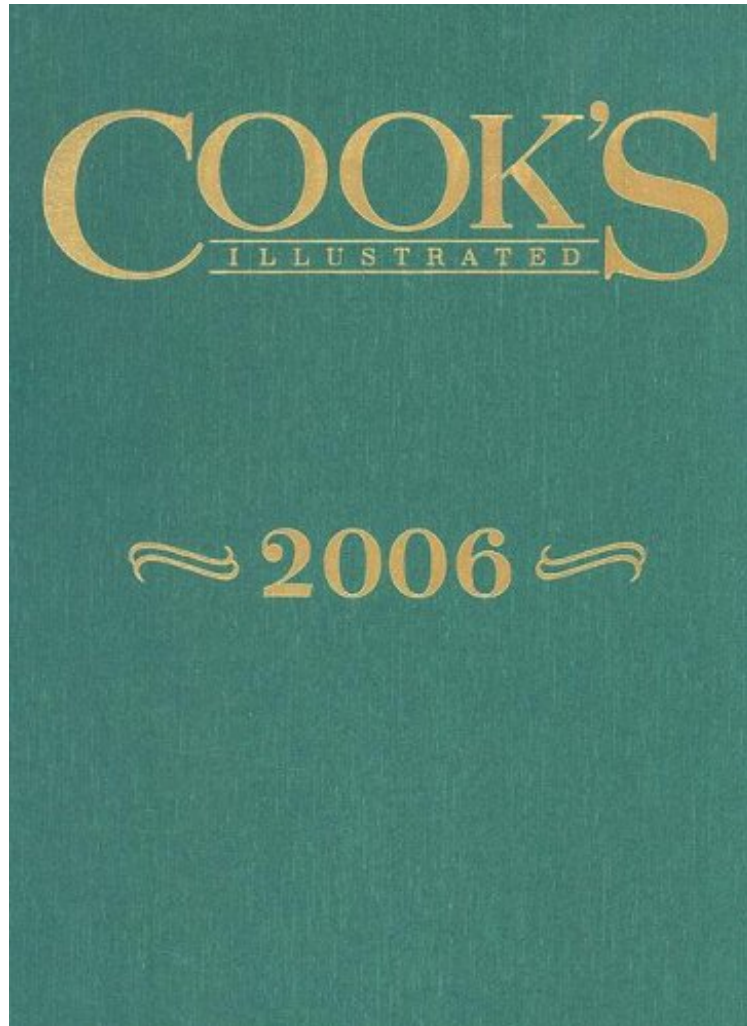

But as the years have passed (this began in 1993) they are gradually expanding their repertoire. There have always been some versions of Latin, Italian, and Asian dishes, but this is the first annual (as far as I can recall) in which Chicken Kiev appears. Cholesterol-conscious cooks may not be thrilled, but I am. I love that recipe! Other chicken recipes include a pot pie, a version of coq au vin, roast chicken, Moroccan chicken, teriyaki chicken and a few chicken salads. Naturally, meats, fish, vegetables and plenty of desserts are on hand as well, but I was more impressed in this annual by the chicken. You will also find reviews of kitchen equipment, tips (like keeping moist or dirty cookbook pages from sticking together), food

science, editorials and letters to the editor, and essays that explain how the team reached their great results in the recipes. By now, there are some incredible cookbook compilations by Cook's Illustrated and their offspring, America's Test Kitchen, including a 2,000 recipe monster book (which doesn't contain equipment reviews or any of the other features of the magazine).
