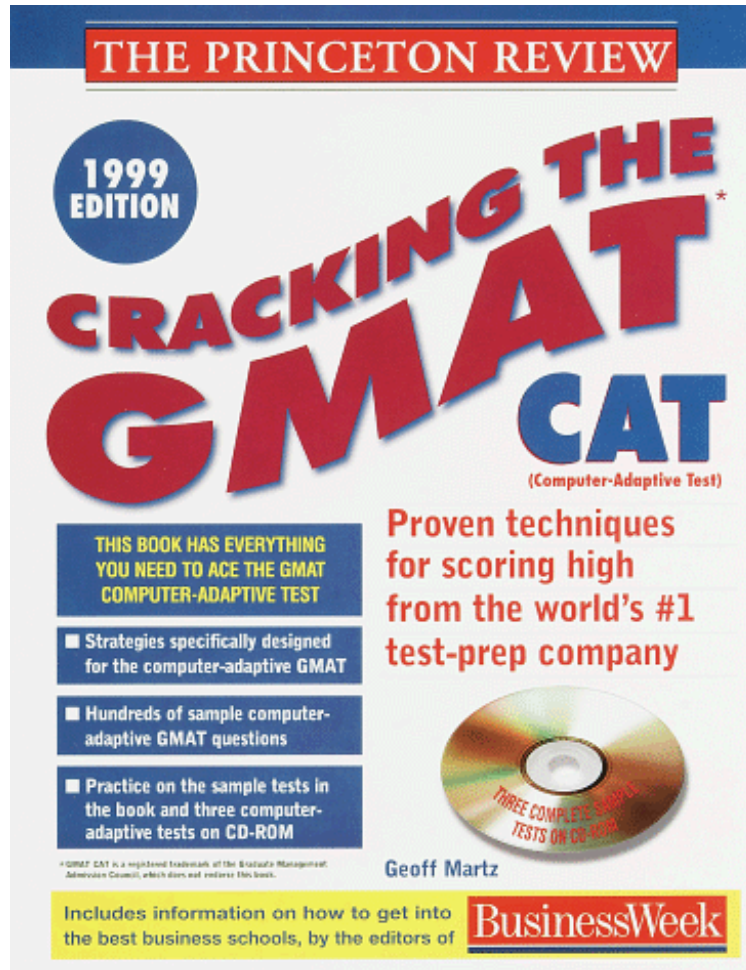

I doubt is bugs alone, it is clearly defective. The style and format are very different from ETS- extremely ugly, very hard to see and different even from princeton's own web tester (which is beautiful and identical to ETS which is the way it should have been). In my case, there is no "time" icon, no "review" icon, and no menu bar, or tool bar. Even to get out -"exit", you will have to wait to do one or two questions before you are allowed to exit. I ordered this book from Melbourne australia, waited 12 weeks plus for the cd. It is a

complete flop. I e-mailed Princeton, and guess what? They said they took out the menu bar at the last minute! You cannot believe this can you? No menu bar is ok. but no icons but "print", "next" and "help" and no control of your practices? I don't think so. I have not even got to the stage of checking answers and I here comments that even the answers are wrong. I don't even want to try "begin" test. The book made 4 stars, but the cd -10 stars. In law, it is "total failure of consideration" and grossly defective product". I paid expensive aussie dollar for this. No luck...still only one visible. The book focusses more on "tricks" to improve your score than learning, which would be fine if the tricks weren't largely obvious like "process of elimination". It's a good complement to a host of sources, but as one source to prepare, I'd stick to something a little more academic. Disappointed By A Customer I was disappointed that the sample GMAT questions in this book were not real GMAT questions. I found the publication produced by GMAC (which does include real questions) much more useful. I also had problems with the software and when I was taking the sample test I got the same question twice. I did not have this problem with the GMAC Powerprep software. In addition, the test taking strategies outlined in the book are very basic. I would be surprised to learn that any real MBA candidate was not familiar with Process of Elimination.
