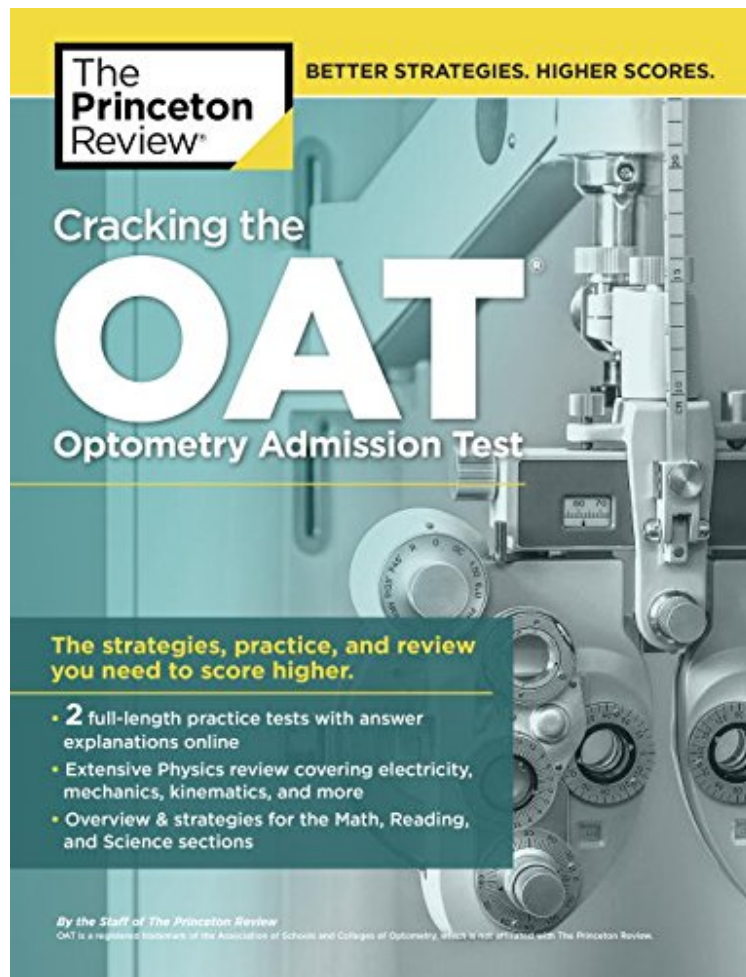

Having said that, it makes sense that the book is priced at this value since it is not necessarily comprehensive.
