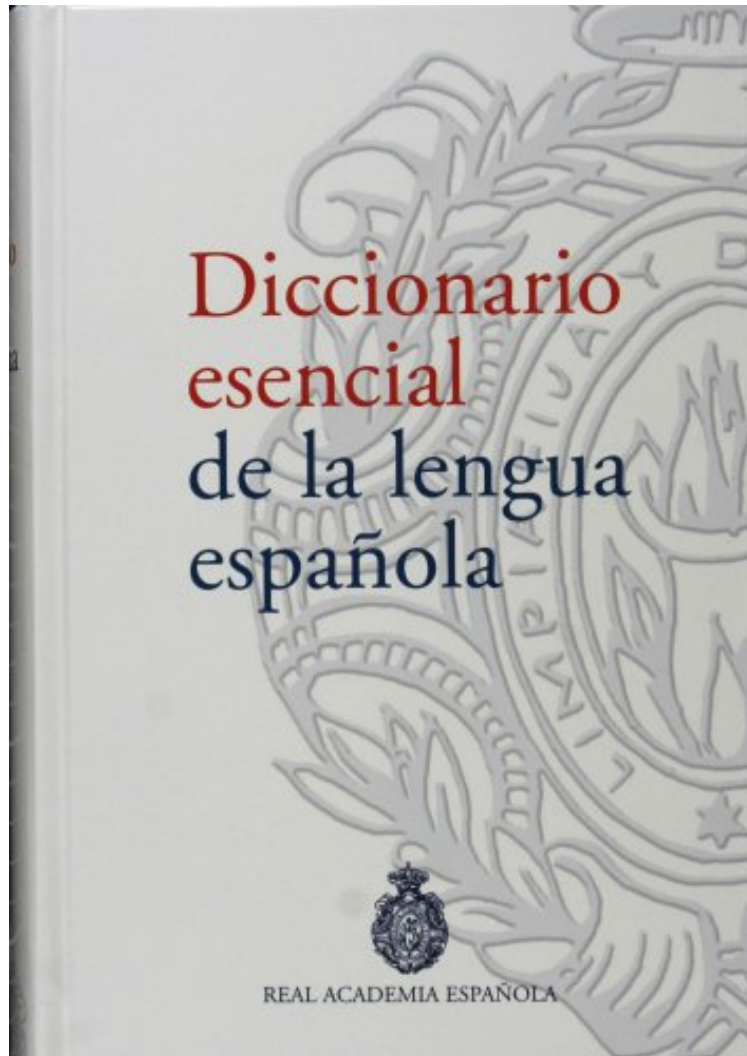

I've been learning Spanish for several years and I've acquired several dictionaries: big, unabridged Sp-Eng items and several specialized Sp-only dictionaries. I like them all. I bought this Diccionario out of curiosity. After all, it's from the Academia! [Note that they also publish delightful editions of famous Spanish

literature]. The "good" about dictionaries is that they are relatively inexpensive. Another "good" is that each dictionary has a place in your library. The "bad" is that when you want to dig deep, sometimes no single dictionary suffices. I've spent several hours with this dictionary, browsing favorite words, etc. and compared its entries with my big, fat Sp-Eng book (there are plenty to choose from). Neither excelled all the time, but por lo general, when I need a dictionary I'd probably grab the big, fat Sp-Eng book before this one. The entries seem more comprehensive and perhaps more entries (though I'm not sure of that). I agree with other reviewers that the book is nicely bound and very readable.
