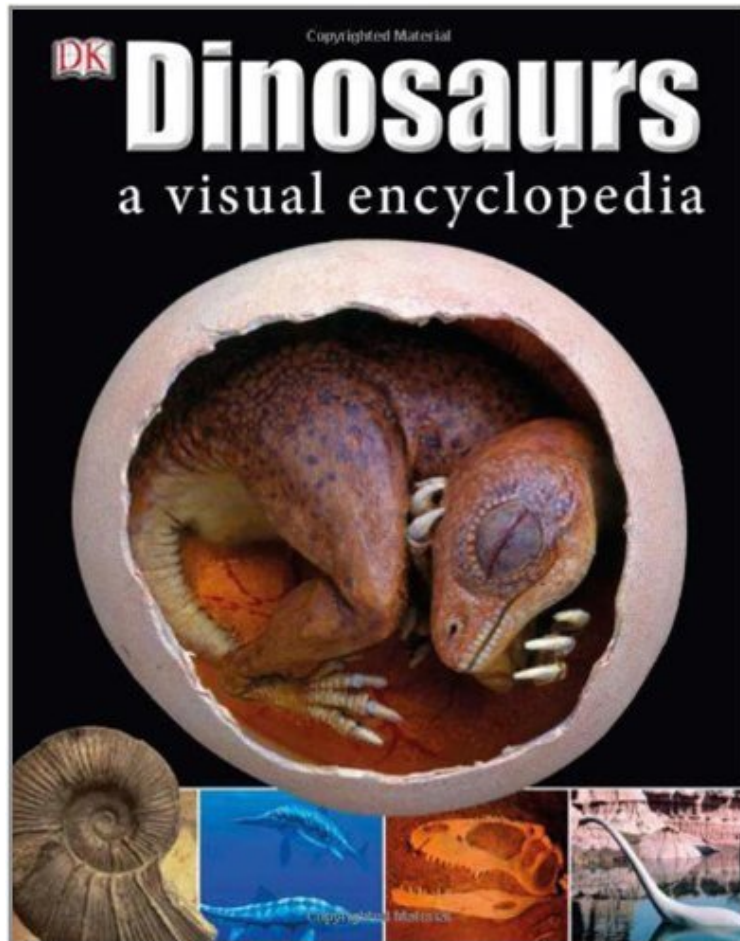

I would call their love of all things prehistoric an obsession. I thought they would love this book, and I was right. All of the pages are in color, including the table of contents, glossary, and index. The depictions of the animals appear to be enhanced with computer graphics and some are very realistic. The print is also to the edge of the page. When I ask the kids what they think, they rated it very high on their all-time favorite book on prehistoric animals.

They do wish that the descriptions would have included height and not just length. I appreciate the pronunciation of each of the animals, since it is inevitable that I am eventually asked to help pronounce these.
