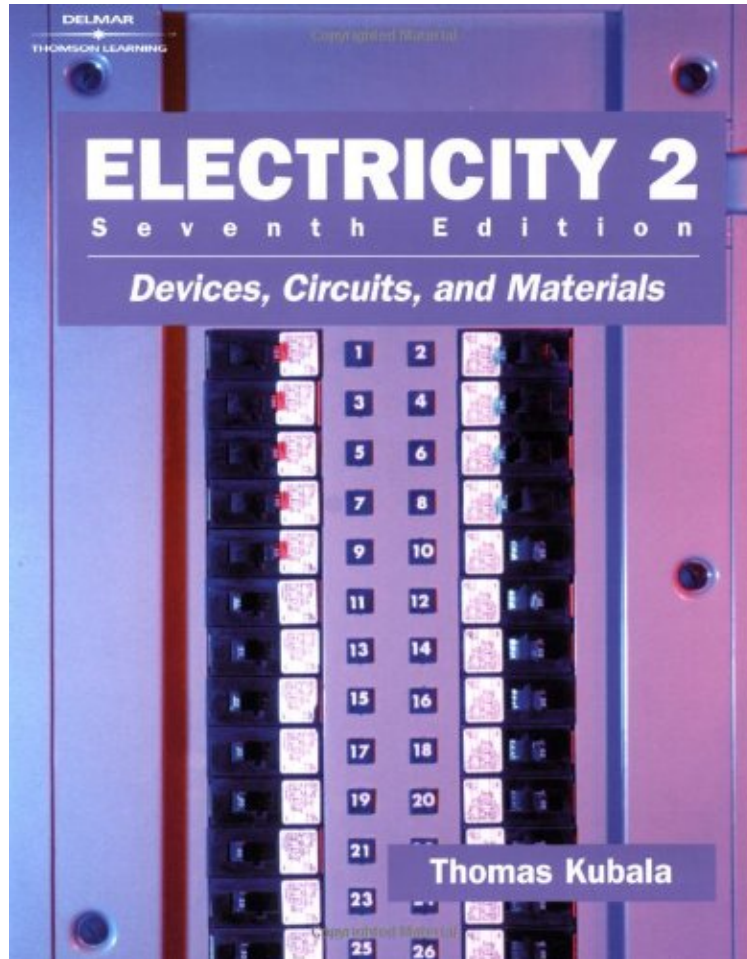


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## Electricity 2: Devices, Circuits and Materials
