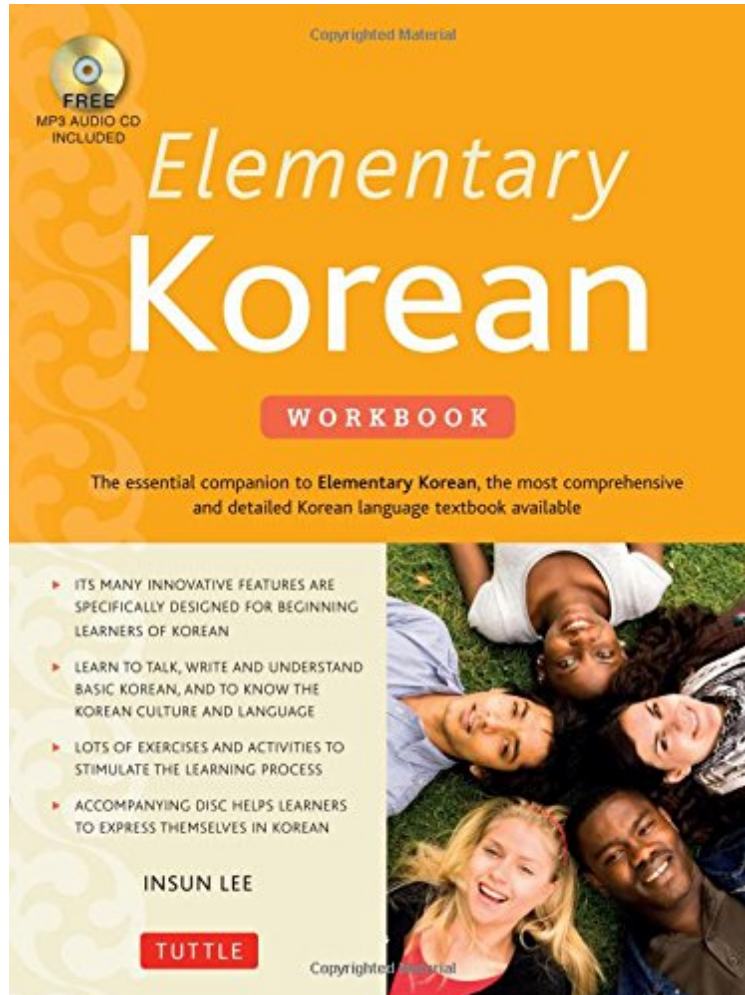

While I was excited to get this book, and it DOES have value, it either has several type errors, or is difficult to use due to the phonetic writing (it is not the mainstream phonetic writing one would expect to see). There is an MP3 CD, but with a lot of laptop computers today it has no where to go...no CD player...Also, because it is a workbook, one should likely purchase the TEXTBOOK to completely know what is going on.
