For instance a picture of an octopus has labels printed indicating "tentacle" and "suction cup" but only the first one has an audio tag which blandly states, "An octopus has 8 legs."Or for the life-cycle of an insect, (egg, larva, pupa, adult) wouldn't you expect the audio to pronounce each phase?
