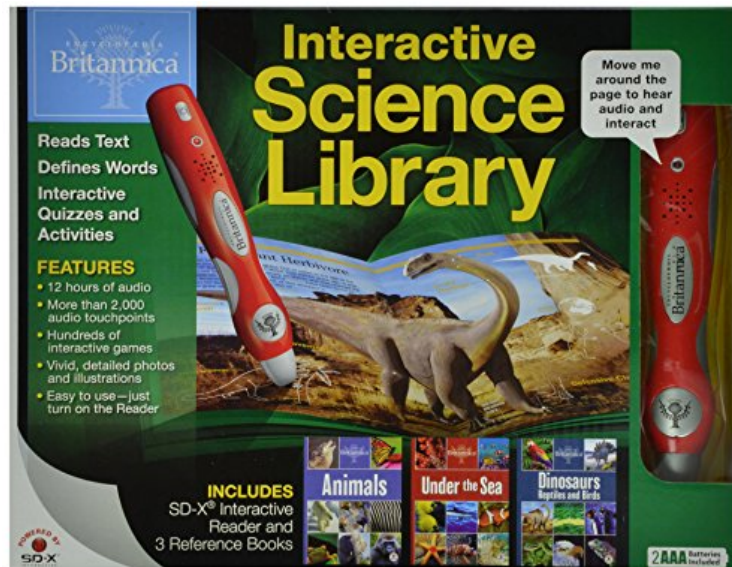

On each page, there are not as many "audio hotspots" as I would have expected. For instance a picture of an octopus has labels printed indicating "tentacle" and "suction cup" but only the first one has an audio tag which blandly states, "An octopus has 8 legs." Or for the life-cycle of an insect, (egg, larva, pupa, adult) wouldn't you expect the audio to pronounce each phase? But no, it says stuff like, "this phase lasts 2 weeks." The three books in this set are "stiff" softback, and the pages themselves seem pretty strong, but the glue in the binding has dried up and pages are falling out after just a few days of use since the books doesn't lay flat, you have the instinct to press down to keep it open. Strong points about the books are the large colorful pictures and photographs and engaging graphic design/layout. Each double-page spread is pretty much a stand-alone module which engages a child for about 5-10 minutes.
